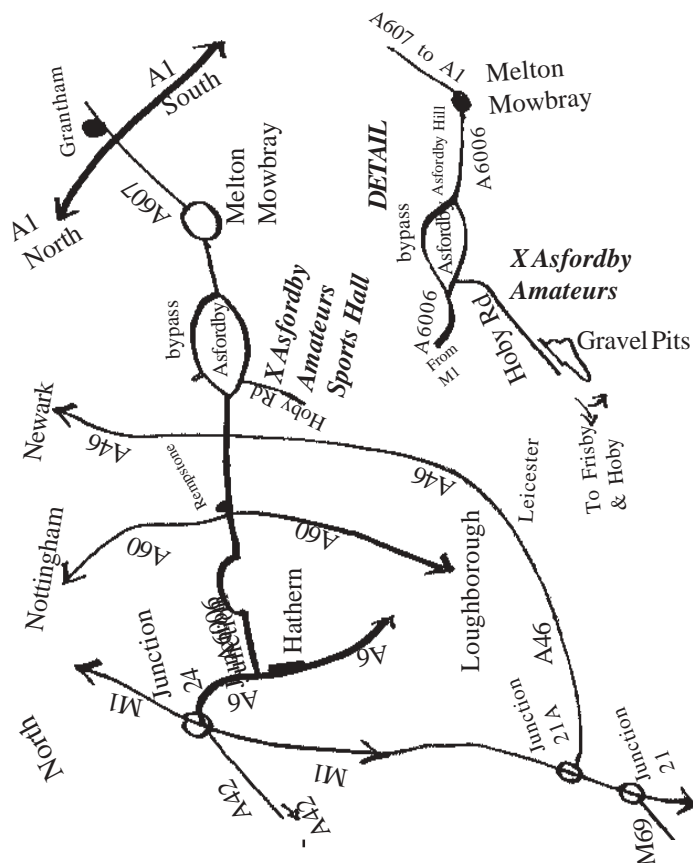


### DIRECTIONSTOVENUE

Exhibitors using the M1 leave at Junction 24, take the A6 south heading towards Loughborough. Go through Kegworth and immediately before Hathern take a left turn onto the A6006 to Melton Mowbray. Continue on this road until you come to the Asfordby ringroad, take the turning on your right into the village and the next immediate right (there is a small cemetery on your left) onto the Hoby Rd. The Sports Centre is approx ½ mile down the lane on your left.

Exhibitors using the A1 leave at the A607 turning to Melton Mowbray. Follow the ringroad through the town onto the A6006 to Loughborough, bypass Asfordby then take the lefthand turning back into the village. Take the first turning on your right onto the Hoby Rd. The Sports Centre is approx ½ mile down the lane on your left.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

1. In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.
2. Show awards issued by the Irish Kennel Club which count towards the title of Champion, shall be five point Green Stars or more.
3. Wins at Championship Shows in Breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.
4. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.
5. In estimating the number of awards won all wins up to & including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class ie. **8th January 2007**
6. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First prize does not include a Special prize of whatever value.
7. If an exhibitor reports before judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-
  1. Withdrawal - the dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) & 20.
  2. Transfer - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of their being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy & Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months or 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
c) For any reason other than above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
8. If an exhibitor arrives late & misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may NOT be transferred to any other class.

- MINOR PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- JUNIOR:** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- NOVICE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First prizes at Open or Championship Shows (Puppy, Special Puppy, Minor Puppy & Special Minor Puppy Classes excepted) whether restricted or not.
- GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit & Open Classes, whether restricted or not.
- POST GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes, whether restricted or not.
- LIMIT:** For dogs which have not won three Challenge Certificates under three different judges or seven or more First prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit & Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
- OPEN:** For all dogs of the Breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at this Show.
- VETERAN:** For dogs of not less than seven years of age and over on the day of the Show.
- SPEC CHALLENGE:** For owner, handler or exhibit never having won an award counting to title of Champion (ie KC Challenge Certificate)
- BRACE:** For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **OPENING OF SHOW:** The Show will open at 10.30am
2. **ARRIVAL OF DOGS:** Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging.
3. **JUDGING TIME:** Judging will commence at 11.00am & exhibitors will be responsible for their dogs being on time for judging.
4. **REMOVAL OF DOGS:** Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. **COOKING STOVES:** The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting & benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Manager.
6. **ENTRY FEES:** Members: First entry £4.00 Per Dog. Non-Members: First entry £6.00 Per Dog  
Subsequent Classes with same dog: Members £1.00. Non Members £2.00
7. **PRIZE MONEY:** 1st £2.00, 2nd £1.50, 3rd £1.00, Best in Show £5, Best Puppy in Show £5.
8. **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
9. **PUPPIES:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. **MATING OF BITCHES:** The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** Where a Best Puppy in Show is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed & is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same Show. A puppy is a dog of six & not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed or Best in Show is a puppy it will automatically be Best Puppy in Breed & Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively.  
Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.  
**WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION:** Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety classes when judged before Breed Classes.  
**PROVISO:** For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. **BEST IN SHOW:** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed & is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex providing they are unbeaten winning dogs. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show.  
**WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION:** Dogs which become eligible for Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than Breed classes & Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show & Reserve Best in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety classes when judged before Breed Classes.  
**PROVISO:** For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of 10 minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Manager.

PLEASE KEEP OUR VENUE CLEAN AND TIDY,  
AND ALL DOGS AND CHILDREN UNDER CONTROL

14. **REGULATIONS:** No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the canine press wherever possible.
15. **PREPARATION FOR EXHIBITION:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F Annex B - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
16. **DOG FOULING:** Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is requested to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog/s at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue & within the environs of that event including car & caravan parks & approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.

## **REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITIONS F (B)**

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition at a Show. When a dog is found to have been prepared for exhibition at a Show in contravention of these regulations the exhibitor will be dealt with as if a complaint under Kennel Club Rule 42 had been lodged against them & proved to the satisfaction of the General Committee without prejudice to the right of the exhibitor to make representations to the General Committee in mitigation of the penalty to be imposed at the discretion of the General Committee under Rule A42. The dog will be automatically disqualified from exhibition at the Show & from any award gained thereat.
2. No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition either before or at the Show. Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat of a dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed & nothing may be done, calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive, except: -
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed
  - (c) The shortening of tails of customarily docked breeds.
  - (d) Operations to prevent breeding provided such operations have been reported to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are showed.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination & analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by any official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show & the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The Officers & Committee of the Midland Border Terrier Club do not accept responsibility for any products advertised or sold by Stall Holders and/or Trade Stands at this Show. Exhibitors are reminded that products on sale by Trade Stands for the preparation & grooming of dogs may not meet the requirements for the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
